Section 2. Load Contaminants

Contaminants - items totally prohibited. No person shall dump or cause to be dumped any of the following described waters or wastes to the Pickerel Lake Sanitary District's evaporation pond, or lagoon, located on 197th Street:

- a. Any gasoline, benzene, naphtha, fuel oil, or other flammable or explosive liquid, solid, or gas.
- b. Any waters or wastes containing toxic or poisonous solids, liquids, or gasses in sufficient quantity, either singly or by interaction with other wastes, to injure or interfere with any sewage treatment process, constitute a hazard to humans or animals, create a public nuisance, or create any hazard in the receiving waters of the evaporation pond, or lagoon, including but not limited to cyanides in excess of two (2) milligrams per liter as CN in the wastes as dumped to the District's evaporation pond or lagoon.
- c. Any waters or wastes having a pH lower than 5.5 or having any other corrosive property capable of causing damage or hazard to structures, equipment, and personal of the Pickerel Lake Sanitary District.
- d. Any solid or viscous substances in quantities or of such size capable of causing interference with the proper operation of the evaporation pond or lagoon such as, but not limited to ashes, cinders, sand, mud, straw, shavings, metal, glass, rags, feathers, tar, plastics, wood, underground garbage, whole blood, paunch manure, hair and fleshing's, end trails and paper dishes, cups, milk containers, etc., either whole or ground by garbage grinders.
- e. The Board of Trustees of the Pickerel Lake Sanitary District, or their employees, reserve the right to further prohibit specifically designated and described substances, materials, waters, or wastes if it appears likely in the opinion of the Board, or a PLSD employee, that such wastes can harm the evaporation pond or lagoon, any sewage treatment process, or equipment, or can otherwise endanger life, limb, public property or constitute a nuisance.
