PLSD Welcomes You Back!

For seasonal cabin owners, we offer a few helpful tips the first time you use your cabin after the long winter. To avoid sewer gas odors, run all your faucets for a bit before flushing the toilets for the first time. Sewer traps dry up with nonuse, so washing them out first helps eliminate the odors.

PLSD Requires Sump Pump Discharge Outside April 1st

PLSD Ordinance 13 allows sump pumps to discharge into the sewer system November 1st – April 1st. Customers in need of sump pumps over the winter months should move their sump pump discharge hoses to the outside by April 1st. PLSD reminds you that you must complete a sump pump permit. You can find the permit form in the Customer Information section under [Rates and Fees](#).

PLSD Facilitates Remote Monitoring

If you're interested in being able to monitor your personal sewer system while you're away from your cabin, reach out to System Manager Justin Carlson (605.467.1503). PLSD will order the compatible monitor and coordinate installation with your electrician. You are responsible for the costs, but many owners appreciate the added protection. PLSD is happy to help facilitate your installation project; however, we are not responsible for the system once installed.

PLSD Works With SDRAWS in 2026

Now that we have completed our improvement and expansion project, we have requested South Dakota Rural Association of Wastewater Systems to camera the main sewer line, mark additional clean outs, and conduct a targeted smoke test on the line this fall. PLSD is dedicated to ensuring the system's integrity.
