PLSD Continues With System Upgrades

Initial work has begun on upgrading the system with work completed on the air relief valves. Next steps include replacing the remaining primary lift station pumps and panels which will begin once all the materials become available. Once all the upgrades are completed this summer, the next phase will begin. This includes expanding the system to the cabins located on leased land on the northwest side of the lake. PLSD hopes to begin the excavation work in September. Once the entire project is completed the sewer system will be operating in its most efficient manner since first installed. PLSD Reminds You to Provide Access

As we continue to make improvements, PLSD reminds all cabin owners that you must maintain your property free of encroachments on system components such as manholes, lift stations, and clean out accesses. Cabin owners provided an easement to PLSD when the system was constructed years ago that grants access to the property to work on the sewer system. Examples of obstruction include landscaping, fences, arbors, lamp posts, signs, swing sets, sidewalks, retaining walls, garages, out buildings, etc. When necessary, PLSD will remove any encroachments to gain access, as needed, at the cabin owner’s expense.

PLSD Offers Automatic Withdrawal Payment Option

If you are enrolled in autopay, your invoice will state BANK AUTO PAY in the “TERMS” box at the top of your bill. PLSD’s bank (Dacotah Bank) drafts your account on the 20th day of the billing month.
